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## ROSES IN THE SNOW PATTERN CORRECTIONS

**Note:** When this pattern was edited for print, errors were made at the beginnings of several rows. Instead of starting a row with a hdc or a dc, the pattern should read **Beg hdc** or **Beg dc**. These beginning half-double and double crochet stitches are very easy:

**Beg hdc:** Sc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, ch 1

**Beg dc:** Sc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, ch 2

The top ch is always the top of the stitch. When joining to a beg hdc, sl st to the ch 1. When joining to a beg dc, sl st to the second ch.

### Rose Block Corrections:

**Rnd 7:** Working in back loops only, sl st to center hdc of petal. Ch 1, [beg dc, 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc] in same st (ctr hdc of petal). Work the rest of the rnd as written.

**Rnd 8:** Ch 1, (Beg dc, ch 1, dc) in same st as joining, continue rnd as written. (sc, ch 3 = a beg dc and a ch 1).

**Rnd 9:** as written

**Rnd 10:** Ch 1, beg dc in 1st sc, continue as written.

### Basketweave Center Corrections:

**Row 1:** *Beg dc* in 2nd ch from hook, dc in each rem ch across. Ch 1, turn.

**Rows 2 - 102:** *Beg hdc* in 1st dc, continue as written.

### Section border:

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, (*sc, ch 3, dc, ch 1, dc*) in corner, continue as written.

### Outside Border Corrections:

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, *beg dc* in 1<sup>st</sup> sc, continue as written.

**Rnd 6:** Ch 1, *Beg shell (beg dc, 6 dc)* in next sc, continue as written.

This is probably clear as mud just reading through, but when you start working, it'll make a lot more sense!
